

OLIDATA HAS BEEN AWARDED A €15.9 MILLION IPZS TENDER TO UPGRADE THE CENTRAL AND SECURITY INFRASTRUCTURE OF THE ELECTRONIC ID CARD SYSTEM

Rome, 30 June 2026 – Olidata S.p.A., an Italian system integrator listed on the Euronext Milan market of Borsa Italiana, has been awarded a contract worth a total of **€15,906,900.00** for the supply and related services for the upgrade of the central and security infrastructure of the **Electronic Identity Card issuance system**, with a duration of 63 months.

The contract, issued by the **Istituto Poligrafico e Zecca dello Stato S.p.A.**, concerns a project of strategic importance for the country, aimed at enhancing the technological infrastructure that underpins one of the main tools for citizen identification and access to digital public services.

The aim is to modernise the existing architecture, overcoming the obsolescence of the equipment and strengthening the capacity of the national Electronic Identity Card (EIC) issuance system to respond reliably and efficiently to the needs of citizens, local authorities, consulates and administrations involved in the processes of issuing and managing the document.

The initiative also involves strengthening the aspects relating to business continuity and service restoration, through **business continuity** and **disaster recovery solutions**. In this way, the new infrastructure will help to make this essential public service more robust and resilient, reducing the risk of disruptions and ensuring greater protection for the digital processes that underpin it.
